Inclement Weather – Field Policy

In case of inclement weather, the Kantor Park fields can and will be closed if deemed necessary by the Recreation Department or its representative. The Long Hill Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel or postpone any game / activity should such action be deemed necessary or desirable and is determined to be in the best interests of the Kantor Park fields, the Township of Long Hill, and the participants in general. Such decision is final. Common sense does prevail, and Safety First!!!

The Long Hill Recreation Department or its representative will contact the specific authorized person listed on the permit for the organization regarding the status of the field in accordance with the Inclement Weather policy.

The field decision will be made as follows:

Monday thru Friday – Prior to 2pm

*If inclement weather occurs after 2pm the Recreation Dept. reserves the right to close the fields with minimal notification.

Saturday or Sunday/after Town Hall Hours M-F – Permit holder will be responsible for making determination using the same criteria. This will be made clear to the permit holder at the time of permit issuance. Failure to follow the stipulations will result in permit forfeiture and possible fees for damages.

Note: If a game, practice or activity is in progress, it is at the discretion of the official or head coach to stop the activity. Remember, common sense should prevail, and Safety First!!!!

***Policy on Lightning/Thunder:** If you hear thunder or see lightning, all play must stop, and fields must be evacuated. <u>A period of not less than 30 minutes must pass with no lightning or thunder before play can resume.</u>
