During discussion, the Board agreed that although the new PSE&G monopoles are taller than the previous monopoles, the replacement towers and cell phone equipment with the new updated modern equipment is essential for functionality in the community. The Board additionally noted that cell phone service would be inadequate without the upgrade in equipment, thus causing detriment to the public good. The Board agreed the benefits of the application outweigh any detriments.

Upon motion made by Mr. Rosenberg and seconded by Mr. Grosskopf, the application was approved subject to a memorializing resolution by the unanimous votes of Mr. Rosenberg, Mr. Grosskopf, Mr. Gianakis, Mr. Malloy, Mr. Hain, Ms. Robertson and Chairman Gerecht; they being all members present and eligible to vote. Vice Chairman Johnson voted against the application.
