WHEREAS, the Township Chief Financial Officer, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.4, has certified that sufficient funds are available to cover the full cost of the contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Long Hill in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- The contract for the operation and maintenance of the Township's Wastewater Treatment System
 for the period from January 1, 2020 through the date of the closing on the sale of the system to
 New Jersey American Water Company is hereby awarded to NSU in accordance with its
 December 10, 2019 bid, the terms of which are incorporated herein, as follows:
 - a. <u>Term</u>: January 1, 2020 through date of closing on sale of plant to New Jersey American Water Company.
 - b. Compensation: \$50,150 per month.
- 2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the contract which was included in the instructions to bidders.
- 3. The Township Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to return the bid bond to Veolia Water North American Operating Services, LLC, which was the second low bidder on the project.
- 4. The Township Clerk is also authorized and directed to return the bid bond of NSU upon receipt of a fully-executed contract and all other required documents.
