Beginning December 10th, the Long Hill Parks and Recreation Dept. will sponsor a Winter Fun Contest. Long Hill Residents--build your own ice sculpture, snowman, igloo, snow fort, etc. out of snow. Let the Parks and Recreation Dept. know about your creation, and we will come out with our judges to see your creation. All entries should be visible from the road and not require judges to enter properties. By registering your creation with us, you give us permission to take a photograph of your sculpture and display it on our website and/or submit it to local newspapers. Only registered sculptures photographed by the Recreation Dept. will be eligible for the contest.

Contest Period: Dec. 10, 2014 – March 15, 2015

Entries will be judged by the Parks and Recreation Dept., and awards will be given for the most creative sculptures. Entries can be by an individual, a group, or family. Winners will be announced at a Township Committee Meeting following the conclusion of the contest. To enter after you have built your masterpiece, register your creation for judging on Community Pass (<https://register.communitypass.net/longhill>).
