Survey of Sanitary Sewer and Manholes Long Hill Wastewater Collection System Updated: January 6, 2021

Please be advised that from about **January 6, 2021 through April 30, 2021**, between the hours of **7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.**, New Jersey American Water's qualified contractor Remington Vernick Engineers (RVE) and its subcontractor CSL Services, Inc. will be conducting a survey and condition assessment of the manholes in the Long Hill wastewater collection system. Additionally, temporary flow metering devices will be placed in some manholes to gather information on the condition of the sewer mains in the service area. CSL Services Inc. will revisit these manholes periodically to check on the flow monitoring devices.

The intent of the project is to develop a hydraulic sewer model that will help better understand capacity limitations throughout the system, minimize capacity related overflows, and manage future system capacity.
